## Workshops

**1. London's Housing Need Facilitated by Shelter.** Discussion on the evidence of housing need in London: numbers on council housing waiting lists, homelessness, overcrowding and rising repossession. Do existing policies genuinely help to address this need and if not, what changes need to occur?

**2. Affordability Facilitated by Planning Aid for London Government;** local, regional and national, talks of 'affordable housing'. What is the current definition of 'affordability'? How can we ensure that the number of 'affordable' homes required in London are provided?

**3. The Fellows Court Experience Facilitated by Fellows Court TRA and London Tenants Federation.** Discussion on our grass roots experience as tenants / tenants associations and using this as evidence to influence new strategies and challenge existing ones.

**4. 'Our homes, our communities' Facilitated by Just Space Planning Network and voluntary sector/equality groups.** What does the draft London Housing Strategy have to say about community and social infrastructure? What else should be included to ensure our homes and our communities are good places to live, to raise the next generation and to grow old in?
